

The Seward County (NE) Hall of Agricultural Achievement

INTRODUCTION

The Seward County Hall of Agricultural Achievement grew out of a plan with the principal objective to gather and compile a history of achievements in agriculture in Seward County, Nebraska. The Seward County Agricultural Society has approved a wall of the Agricultural Pavilion for portraits of men and women whose achievements in agriculture warrant public recognition.

This display is an inspiration to all people of Seward County who are interested in the cause of agriculture. Those people whose achievement in the interests of agriculture have proved of great and lasting benefit to Seward County and the State of Nebraska are worthy of being thus honored.

Only persons who are or who have been actively engaged in agriculture, or actively engaged in promoting the interest of agriculture, and who are residents of Seward County will be selected for recognition by the Hall of Agricultural Achievements. Posthumous nominations may be made. No more than three persons will be selected for recognition each year.

Persons to be recognized will be selected by the Agricultural Committee of the Seward Area Chamber of Commerce. Nominations for consideration need to be received by the Seward Area Chamber of commerce by February 1. Nominations may be made by any person.

ELECTION OF NEW MEMBERS

A. Nominations

The Seward Area Chamber of Commerce shall provide to all interested persons an invitation to nominate possible new members of the Seward County (NE) hall of Agricultural Achievement. Suggestions for membership should be made on a form provided by the Chamber of Commerce office. Nominations must be submitted to the chamber office by February 1 of the year of induction. Each nominator may nominate up to two persons at one time. Persons may be nominated posthumously. No more than three new members will be inducted at any one time.

B. Selection

Following the receipt of the nominations of new members, the Agricultural Committee of the Seward Area Chamber of Commerce will select the new members for the Hall of Agricultural Achievement.

No contact of nominees is to be made by any member of the selection committee prior to the official selection by the committee. Following selection of the new members, the committee will contact the selected new member (or their immediate family for a posthumous nomination) to get their acceptance. New members will be recognized and honored at an appropriate time and place.
